Additionally, Iowa City, Iowa, Galesburg and Quincy, Illinois, are located within 70 miles of West Point.


West Point is a very active and progressive community and includes several recreational areas. We are proud of our beautiful City Park located in the center of the city surrounded by a variety of thriving businesses. South Park Recreation Complex is within walking distance of the city square. Pollmiller Park is just ¼ mile east of West Point. This 86-acre park features fishing with a handicap fishing dock and beach with concession stand, flush toilets and shower facilities. It also has campsites, hiking, and a walking/bike trail.

West Point offers an array of local festivals--from our own Sweet Corn Festival held annually the second weekend in August and several area festivals occurring during the months of June through September. We also have our own police and fire departments.

We have two churches: St. Mary of the Assumption Catholic Church and the Presbyterian Church, listed on the National Historical Society for being the oldest Presbyterian Church in Iowa. We offer choices of education with the new Holy Trinity Catholic Pre-K—6<sup>th</sup> grade school located here in West Point with bus transportation from our City Park to both the Fort Madison and Holy Trinity School Districts.
